- repair, in a timely fashion, environmental damage attributes to Company activities.
- provide for future environmental protection requirements in design and long range planning.

- work with others towards improvement and development of environmental standards and the understanding of environmental issues.
- inform employees, the public and government regarding Company environmental protection activities, and actively respond to concerns of local residents and the general public.
