

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT



Canadian Helicopters regards environmental protection as vital to the conduct of its day-to-day business and future developments. The Company's policy is to:

- ensure that hazards to public health and damage to the environment attributable to Company activities are minimized.
- comply with all laws, regulations and standards relating to the protection of the environment in the conduct of its business.
- properly use and store hazardous materials required in the normal course of business, to ensure that contact with the environment is minimized and limited to established accepted circumstances and conditions.
- provide additional environmental protection beyond that required by law when the benefits to society justify the costs.
- Be cognizant of the effects of Company operations on the environment and provide stewardship at a senior management level to ensure that effective environmental protection measures are maintained.
- ensure that employees understand and accept responsibility for monitoring and protecting the environment and reporting any damage to applicable authorities.
- repair, in a timely fashion, environmental damage attributed to Company activities.
- provide for future environmental protection requirements in design and long-range planning.
- work with others towards improvement and development of environmental standards and the understanding of environmental issues.
- inform employees, the public, and government regarding Company environmental protection activities, and actively respond to the concerns of local residents and the general public.
- Employees shall familiarize themselves with this policy and notify management of any incident in which the environment is threatened or damaged by Company activities.
